CALL FOR STUDENTS' APPLICATIONS

Teaching Activity 1

The Leuphana University, Partner of the Project Account4GreenEco – Sustainability Accounting Learning Platform for a Green Economy – Project n° 2022-1-ES01-KA220-HED-000089844, funded by the National Agency SEPIE (Servicio Español para la Internacionalización de la Educación) in the framework of the European programme ERASMUS+, offers 6 scholarships for students to participate in the Project's Teaching Activity 1 (TA1).

Teaching Activity 1

TA1 consists of a 3-day introductory course on sustainability accounting that will be held in Trento (Italy) from October 24, 2023, to October 27, 2023. TA1 will offer the selected students the opportunity to participate in an international environment with representatives from the other project's universities to learn key concepts of sustainability accounting.

The scholarship covers the selected students' travel, accommodation, and subsistence costs related to TA1. Students participating in TA1 will receive a certificate acknowledging 20 training hours.

Students' requirements

To apply for a scholarship, you must:

- Be a master student on the application date
- Be an applicant for the module and course "Sustainability Accounting and Reporting" by Prof. Schaltegger
- Possess a certified English B1 level.

Please note that with participating in the offered program, your application for taking part in the lectures of the course Sustainability Accounting and Reporting will expire and your placement will be given to another student. However, you can still earn credit points for the program if you will fully participate in all relevant activities (offline and online) and enroll for the exam that will be assigned to the program participation.

Selection criteria

Applicants will be ranked based on their average grade. Additional criteria may be considered in case of a draw in students' grades.

A 40%-60% gender balance will be guaranteed in the selection procedure (at least two selected students of each gender).

Two of the six scholarships will be reserved for students from minority groups, or with disabilities or other difficulties. If the applicants do not meet any of these conditions, these scholarships can be given to other applicants.

Application process

Students must send the following documents to stefan.schaltegger@leuphana.de before April 11, 2023.

- Application form
- Curriculum vitae
- Academic record

The outcome of the selection process will be made public before April 18th.

Acceptance

The selected students must formally accept the reception of the scholarship during the next 10 days after the publication of the selection process result by sending an email to stefan.schaltegger@leuphana.de. Failing to do so will be understood that she/he resigns.

Any waiver of a scholarship that has been previously accepted must be submitted in writing. Accepted resignations will allow the next person on the waiting list to be selected.

In the event that a student does not complete TA1 or part of it or that she/he resigns after accepting the scholarship and costs on her/his behalf have already been incurred, Leuphana University reserves the right to claim the full or partial amount of the scholarship.
