CALL FOR STUDENTS' APPLICATIONS

Teaching Activity 1

Montpellier Business School, Partner of the Project Account4GreenEco – Sustainability Accounting Learning Platform for a Green Economy – Project nº 2022-1-ES01-KA220-HED-000089844, funded by the National Agency SEPIE (*Servicio Español para la Internacionalización de la Educación*) in the framework of the European programme ERASMUS+, **offers 6 scholarships for students to participate in the Project's Teaching Activity 1 (TA1).**

Teaching Activity 1

TA1 consists of a 3-day introductory course on sustainability accounting that will be held in Trento (Italy) from October 24, 2023, to October 27, 2023. TA1 will offer the selected students the opportunity to participate in an international environment with representatives from the other project's universities to learn key concepts of sustainability accounting.

The scholarship covers the selected students' travel, accommodation, and subsistence costs related to TA1. Students participating in TA1 will receive a certificate of attendance.

Students' requirements

To apply for a scholarship, you must:

- Be either (a) a last-year bachelor student or (b) a master student on the application date.
- Possess a certified English B1 level.

Please note that accounting skills are not required. Students who wish to complement their education with specific learning in sustainability accounting to improve their knowledge or gather new skills are encouraged to apply.

Selection criteria

In the case of multiple applications, applicants will be ranked based on their average grade. Additional criteria may be considered in case of a draw in students' grades.

A 40%-60% gender balance will be guaranteed in the selection procedure (at least two selected students of each gender).

Two of the six scholarships will be reserved for students from minority groups, or with disabilities or other difficulties. If the applicants do not meet any of these conditions, these scholarships can be given to other applicants.

Application process

Students must send the following documents to Juliette Senn (j.senn@montpellier-bs.com) before May 23, 2023.

- Application form
- Curriculum vitae
- English level certificate

The outcome of the selection process will be made public by June 6, 2023.

Acceptance

The selected students must formally accept the reception of the scholarship during the next 10 days (by June 16, 2023) after the publication of the selection process result by sending an email to j.senn@montpellier-bs.com. Failing to do so will be understood that she/he resigns.

Any waiver of a scholarship that has been previously accepted must be submitted in writing. Accepted resignations will allow the next person on the waiting list to be selected.

In the event that a student does not complete TA1 or part of it or that she/he resigns after accepting the scholarship and costs on her/his behalf have already been incurred, Montpellier Business School reserves the right to claim the full or partial amount of the scholarship.
