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## CALL FOR STUDENTS' APPLICATIONS

### Teaching Activity 2

**Montpellier Business School (MBS)**, Partner of the Project Account4GreenEco – Sustainability Accounting Learning Platform for a Green Economy – Project nº 2022-1-ES01-KA220-HED-000089844, funded by the National Agency SEPIE (Servicio Español para la Internacionalización de la Educación) in the framework of the European programme ERASMUS+, **offers 6 scholarships for students to participate in the Project's Teaching Activity 2 (TA2).**

#### Teaching Activity 2

TA2 consists of a 4-day introductory course on sustainability accounting that will be held in at the University of Leuphana (Lünerbug, Germany) **from November 5, 2024, to November 8, 2024** (please consider a travel day before and after the activity). TA2 will offer the selected students the opportunity to participate in an international environment with representatives from the other project's universities to learn key concepts of sustainability accounting.

The scholarship covers the selected students' travel, accommodation, and subsistence costs for TA2. Students participating in TA2 will receive a certificate acknowledging 35 training hours (22,5 hours during the activity and 12,5 hours as preparatory work prior to the activity).

#### Students' requirements

To apply for a scholarship, you must:

- Be a student on the application date.
- Possess a certified English B1 level (optional but may be valued in the application).

Please note that no specific skills are required. Students who wish to complement their education with specific learning in sustainability accounting and reporting to improve their knowledge or gather new skills are encouraged to apply.

#### Selection criteria

Applicants will be ranked based on their average grade. Additional criteria may be considered in case of a draw in students' grades.



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A 40%-60% gender balance will be guaranteed in the selection procedure (at least two selected students of each gender).

Two of the six scholarships will be reserved for students from minority groups, or with disabilities or other difficulties. If the applicants do not meet any of these conditions, these scholarships can be given to other applicants.

### **Application process**

- Curriculum vitae
- Academic record
- English level certificate (optional as specified above)

The outcome of the selection process will be made public by June 3, 2024.

### **Acceptance**

The selected students must formally accept the reception of the scholarship during the next 10 days (by June 13, 2024) after the publication of the selection process result by sending an email to [j.senn@montpellier-bs.com](mailto:j.senn@montpellier-bs.com). Failing to do so will be understood that she/he resigns.

Any waiver of a scholarship that has been previously accepted must be submitted in writing. Accepted resignations will allow the next person on the waiting list to be selected.

In the event that a student does not complete TA2 or part of it or that she/he resigns after accepting the scholarship and costs on her/his behalf have already been incurred, **MBS reserves the right to claim the full or partial amount of the scholarship to guarantee that the next student in the waiting list can attend.** No provision that excludes the obligation to reimburse in the event that the student is unable to participate in the project is included.
