## CALL FOR STUDENTS' APPLICATIONS

### Teaching Activity 2

The Leuphana University of Lüneburg, Partner of the Project Account4GreenEco – Sustainability Accounting Learning Platform for a Green Economy – Project nº 2022-1-ES01-KA220-HED-000089844, funded by the National Agency SEPIE (Servicio Español para la Internacionalización de la Educación) in the framework of the European programme ERASMUS+, offers 6 scholarships for students to participate in the Project's Teaching Activity 2 (TA2).

#### **Teaching Activity 2**

TA2 consists of a 3-day introductory course on sustainability accounting that will be held in at the University of Leuphana, Lüneburg, from November 6, 2024, to November 8, 2024. TA2 will offer the selected students the opportunity to participate in an international environment with representatives from the other project's universities to learn key concepts of sustainability accounting.

The scholarship covers the selected students' subsistence costs for TA2. Students participating in TA2 will receive a certificate acknowledging participation in the programme, and provided successful completion of the assessment, Leuphana students will have this considered as a completed 2-SWS seminar.

#### **Students' requirements**

To apply for a scholarship, you must:

- Be either (a) a last-year bachelor student or (b) a master student on the application date.
- English language proficiency equivalent or above B1 level.

#### **Selection criteria**

Applicants will be ranked based on their average grade. Additional criteria may be considered in case of a draw in students' grades.

Achieving a balance of diverse genders in the selected student group will be a criterion in the selection procedure.

Two of the six scholarships will be reserved for students from minority groups, or with disabilities or other difficulties. If the applicants do not meet any of these conditions, these scholarships can be given to other applicants.

### **Application process**

The submission window for applications will be open until the 25<sup>th</sup> of June, 2024. Applications will be processed on a rolling basis.

The outcome of the selection process will be made public before the 1<sup>st</sup> of July, 2024.

### **Acceptance**

The selected students must formally confirm participation in the course during the next 10 days after the publication of the selection process result by sending an email to [julia.benkert@leuphana.de](mailto:julia.benkert@leuphana.de). Failing to do so will be understood as resignation from the programme. In case of failure to confirm participation, or resignation, the next person on the waiting list will be offered a place in the programme.
